## For Marsh & McLennan Companies, Inc. Group Benefits Plan

This is a summary of the annual report of the Marsh & McLennan Companies, Inc. Group Benefits Plan, EIN 36-2668272, Plan No. 503, for the period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

## **Insurance Information**

The plan has contracts with Hyatt Legal Plans, Inc., National Union Fire Ins. Co. of Pittsburgh, PA, Cigna Health and Life Insurance Co and Affiliates, Vision Service Plan, Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, and Hartford Life Insurance Company to pay certain health, vision, life insurance, long-term disability, legal, and accidental death & dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2014 were \$7,124,103.

Because the Vision Service Plan insurance contract is a so called "experience-rated" contract, the premium cost is affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2014, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contract were \$2,869,127 and the total of all benefit claims paid under this contract during the plan year was \$2,718,713.
